

**The project «E-volution: bringing Europe to another level»  
was funded with the support of the European Union under  
the Programme "Europe for Citizens"**

**4 events have been carried out within this project:**

**Event 1: “Euro-skepticism, euro-criticism and citizens’ movements: another Europe is possible?”**

**Participation:** The event involved 80 citizens, including 50 participants from Italy, 10 participants from Greece, 10 participants from Poland and 10 participants from Catalonia/Spain.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Torino, Italy, from 3/7/2015 to 6/7/2015.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to reflect upon the issues of euro-skepticism, euro-criticism and citizens’ movements.

**Event 2: “Cultural diversity and Europe: where is the link?”**

**Participation:** The event involved 284 citizens, including 10 participants from Italy, 254 participants from Greece, 10 participants from Poland and 10 participants from Catalonia/Spain.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Thessaloniki, Greece, from 11/12/2015 to 14/12/2015.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to introduce the topic of Cultural Diversity and to link it to an analysis of Europe in the current days.

**Event 3: “Volunteering in action for Europe”**

**Participation:** The event involved 112 citizens, including 10 participants from Italy, 10 participants from Greece, 81 participants from Poland and 11 participants from Catalonia/Spain.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Warsaw, Poland, from 05/05/2016 to 08/05/2016.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to explore volunteering and how it can apply to the citizens’ empowerment for the European unity process.

**Event 4: “E-volution: bringing Europe to another level”**

**Participation:** The event involved 128 citizens, including 10 participants from Italy, 10 participants from Greece, 10 participants from Poland and 98 participants from Catalonia/Spain.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Barcelona, Spain, from 08/07/2016 to 11/07/2016.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to create a showroom of tools developed in different countries by the local working groups to stimulate people’s interest and active participation in order to re-think the idea of European construction with a bottom-up approach.
